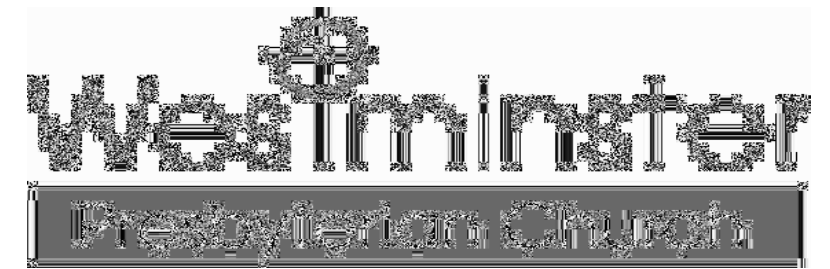

Westminster Presbyterian Church will be hosting Family Promise **March 21-28**. The volunteer signup sheet is posted on the Family Promise bulletin board in the Hospitality Center area. It's getting full, but set-up and breakdown crews are still needed.
