Small Group Opportunities

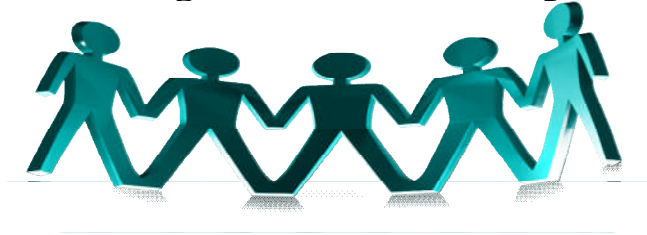
