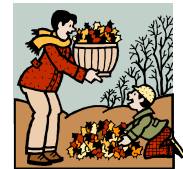

The Alpha Course: Explore The Meaning of Life – Parlor

If you could ask God one question, what would it be? Why do bad things happen to good people? Are all religions the same? Why did Jesus have to die? Did Jesus really rise from the dead? How can I be assured of my faith? How can I read and understand the Bible? How and why should I pray? Join us on Sundays in the Parlor as we explore these questions and more through the Alpha course.

Studies on Books of the Bible

Pilgrim Class: I Peter – Room 13

Out of his firsthand knowledge as an apostle of Christ, Peter shows us what the story of Jesus' life means for us as we take up our cross and follow him. Our study will consist of a straightforward and helpful exposition of this significant epistle.

Serendipity Class: Joshua – Room 7

Serendipity means “an aptitude for making desirable discoveries by accident.” Join us as we make discoveries about God's Word together. We will read and study the book

of Joshua chapter by chapter to gain insight of the book as a whole, the history of God's people, and God's Word for us today. Members rotate in facilitating these class-led discussions.

Women at the Well: Women of the Old Testament – Room 5

This women's class began this year, and it is growing fast! We have been working through the Old Testament studying both the well-known and lesser-known women of the Bible. Learn how these fascinating women shaped the Church of today. Women of all ages and stages of life are welcome.

Friendship Class: Covenant Communities – Room 10/Library

We will begin with Joshua as he leads the Israelites into the Promised Land. We will also look at Judges and a few prophets as they try to convince God's people to remain in covenant with God. We will then learn from Jesus about the New Testament covenant. Finally, we will consider the covenant and the church of Jesus Christ.

Study of Theology

Acts 29: Book of Confessions – Room 22

What is the PCUSA *Book of Confessions* about? Why do we have a *Book of Confessions*? What do the confessions say? What is the history and context of the confessions? How do they reconcile with Scripture? These are just some of the

questions we'll be considering together on Sunday mornings in Room 22.

Christian Living: Prayer: Does It Make Any Difference? – Room 6

In his book, Philip Yancey explores the mysterious intersection where you and God meet and relate. Writing as a fellow pilgrim, he explores the questions surrounding prayer that we may wonder about but not know how to express. Above all, Yancey shows us how to pray to a God who sees what lies ahead of you, knows what lies within you, and invites you into an eternal partnership with Him – through prayer.

Young Adults: The Life You've Always Wanted – Bride's/Prayer Room

What does true spiritual life really look like? What keeps us from living such a life, and what can we do to pursue it? In his book, John Ortberg will guide us on the road to transformation that anyone can take, the road that leads to the life you've always wanted. Don't miss this exciting study led by Rev. Financial Peace University
What could the people of God do for the Kingdom of God? Dave Ramsey's class will show us what we can do for the Kingdom as we learn to beat debt, build wealth, and live like no one else. The average family saves \$2,300 and pays off \$5,700 in debt in the course of the 13-week class. The class meets from 10:15am-12:15pm and consists of video and discussion. Class materials are \$100. Scholarships are available. Class starts on September 20.
